BUILDING 429 HEADLINES SPRING 2011 “LISTEN TO THE SOUND TOUR”

Band Joined By Special Guests Revive and Anthem Lights

(NASHVILLE, Tenn.) March 22, 2011—Dove-winning, pop/rock band **Building 429** will debut new music from its forthcoming Essential Records album release, titled *Listen To The Sound*, on its 20-city tour kicking off this week. The “Listen to the Sound Tour” will additionally feature guest artists, Australian rockers **Revive** and pop foursome **Anthem Lights**.

Opening tomorrow in Iowa City, Iowa, the “*Listen to the Sound Tour*” will make its way cross-country from California to New York, promising fans a night of high-energy music with spiritual depth. In addition to new songs, **Building 429** will be introducing new live elements to its show as well.

Building 429 frontman Jason Roy explains, “Not only will we be playing six or seven new songs off of the new record, but we’ll also be displaying a new show for the first time in some years. We’ve been trying out bits and pieces on the ‘Winter Blast Tour’ and getting awesome response, so we can’t wait to roll the whole thing out on the spring tour!”

Building 429 is best known for its 2004 breakout hit “Glory Defined,” which was named BMI’s Christian Song of the Year in 2005, and that same year **Building 429** was named New Artist of the Year at the Gospel Music Association’s Dove Awards. From that launching point the band has been tirelessly playing 150 live shows a year, developing their own touring brands “Winter Blast” and “SummerFest,” and growing its dedicated fan base. The band will release its fifth album, *Listen To The Sound*, on May 10, as the title track and lead single see tremendous support at radio with adds from **K-LOVE**, **Air 1** and **WAY-FM** networks, plus commitments from **52 AC** and **CHR** markets to date. About Revive:

Dove-nominated, high-energy band Revive’s momentous climb continues with its current sophomore album *Blink* (6/22/10). Produced by the 2010 Dove Award-winning “Producer of the Year” team of Jason Ingram and Rusty Varenkamp, the album’s hit title track saw success at both Christian AC and CHR radio formats, propelling into the Top 10 songs in the country on *Billboard*’s CHR format. Originally from Sydney, Australia, the vibrant pop/rock outfit first caught the attention of Third Day frontman Mac Powell, who encouraged the group to move to Atlanta.

Following that leap of faith, the band signed with Essential Records and recorded its U.S. debut with Powell handling production duties. Since then, Revive has been constantly touring the country opening for artists like Big Daddy Weave, Sanctus Real, DecembeRadio, and of course, Third Day. Revive also toured 2010 as part of the 44-city WinterJam tour, and earned its first Dove Award nomination in the coveted New Artist of the Year category for the 41st Annual GMA Dove Awards.
