RED REVS "NOTHING AND EVERYTHING" TOUR, EXTENDING TREK INTO FEBRUARY 2010

Powerhouse Lineup Includes Pillar, The Wedding and Me In Motion

(Nashville, Tenn.) January 14, 2010 -- Essential Records rock band **RED** kicks off a jam-packed January, which will include celebrating its second career GRAMMY nomination at the awards show at the end of the month, by launching its 2010 "Nothing And Everything" tour tonight in Fort Smith, Arkansas.

The tour also features fellow hard rock band (and labelmates) **Pillar**, along with special guests **The Wedding** and **Me In Motion**.

The "Nothing And Everything" tour is a meeting of two rock powerhouse bands: RED, which has established itself among the upper echelon of rock bands in just three short years, and Pillar, a band that has helped to pioneer the Christian hard music movement. Touring together for the first time, both bands will bring their signature brand of rock to one stage for a riveting concert event.

Randy Armstrong of RED comments, "At our shows, we always play off the energy and enthusiasm of the crowd. We know how enthusiastic our fans are and imagine Pillar's fans are just as wild. The combination is going to be explosive. This will be the rock tour of all rock tours."

"RED has a similar stage dynamic, which makes this a powerful ticket," says Pillar frontman Rob Beckley. "We are excited they asked us to be a part of the tour and look forward to putting on a show our fans, and theirs, can be proud of."

Fans attending a "Nothing And Everything" show can also pick up a free copy of Pillar's "Confessions" book, produced by **Pillar**'s frontman, **Rob Beckley** and **American Bible Society**, aptly titled "Confessions." The "Confessions" book emerges as a resource to address some of the most salient issues affecting youth today: spiritual doubts, sexuality, brokenness and self image. Each section includes thematic confessions, a short devotional, reflection questions and Scriptures references for digging deeper.

The book, an extension of Pillar's hard-hitting *Confessions* album, was inspired by the band's profound spring 2009 "Confessions Tour." A confessional curriculum called "My Secret," taught at the band's local Tulsa, Ok. church, changed the way **Pillar** chose to engage with fans while on tour.

Nashville-based RED, made up of **Michael Barnes** (vocals), **Anthony Armstrong** (guitar) **Randy Armstrong** (bass), and **Joe Rickard** (drums), has logged an impressive 1,000+ live shows since releasing its debut album *End Of Silence* in 2006.

RED's GRAMMY nominated sophomore project, *Innocence & Instinct* (2/7/09) released with more than 40,000 in first week sales and climbed its way to the Top 5 on iTunes Top Albums chart. To date, the band has earned eight consecutive No. 1 radio singles, the last three of which are from *Innocence & Instinct*. The band simultaneously released a Deluxe Edition of *Innocence & Instinct* that includes four bonus tracks and a DVD featuring the "Death of Me" music video, a "making of" documentary and more. Since the 2006 emergence of *End Of Silence* RED has maintained a near-constant presence on the road, touring alongside notable rock names such as Three Days Grace, Flyleaf, 3 Doors Down, Breaking Benjamin, Seether, Papa Roach, Buckcherry, Saving Abel, Sevendust, Staind, Kutless, Trapt, Third Day, Switchfoot and others, and rave reviews for the band's live shows have poured in via both print and online outlets alike.

Over its 10 year career, Pillar has reached nearly 1 million in album sales (including two albums with sales exceeding 300,000 copies each), performed for more than three million people and tallied 10 No. 1 radio singles, 13 Top 5 hits, a GRAMMY nomination, four Dove Awards, nine national headlining tours. *Confessions*, Pillar's sixth studio album -- debuting the talents of new members, bassist Rich Gilliland, drummer Taylor Carroll and new producer, Rob Graves (Red, Wavorly) -- released Sept. 22, 2009. The album has inspired Pillar frontman Rob Beckley to co-author a book elaborating on important themes from the record. Co-produced with the American Bible Society, the book, aptly titled "Confessions," will be available free of charge at tour dates beginning January 14, with book excerpts available at www.pillarmusic.com/confessions.

Pillar's previous studio album, For the Love of the Game (02/26/08), debuted at No. 4 on SoundScan's Christian (overall) album chart. Since Pillar's Dove Award-winning label debut Above in 2001, the band has graced the cover of numerous Christian and mainstream magazines with features in Rolling Stone, Spin, Bass Player, and Hit Parader. The Tulsa, Oklahoma-based band also won Fuse TV's "Next Big Thing" award and has seen its music played on numerous ESPN sports programs, including SportsCenter, Baseball Tonight (during montage highlights from the 2007 World Series) and College Gameday, as well as CBS and FOX Sports.
